Guidelines for Articles in English

Submitting your article

I. Contributions and other editorial correspondence should be sent to Mauro Pesce by e-mail: mauro.pesce@unibo.it

Please, send your contribution in two forms:

(a) a Microsoft Word

and

(b) a pdf copy

II. All manuscripts must include an abstract of about 150-180 words.

III. All articles are submitted to two blind peer reviews.

Formatting guide

I. General rules

1. Fonts

The text must be typed in Unicode Times New Roman
Greek and other ancient languages in Unicode

2. Size

- The text should be typed in size 12.
- Long quotations should be typed in size 10 with a space before and after the quotation and a left indent of 2 cm.
- Footnotes should be typed in size 10.
- Annali di Storia dell'Esegesi (= ASE) NEVER uses bold.

3. Titles

- The name of the author and the main title of the article in Size 16 (NOT in all caps).
- Apart from the main title, all titles are in size 12.
- Titles of sections should be typed in small caps, preceded by a Roman number.
- Titles of subsections should be typed in italics, preceded by an Arabic number.
- Titles of further subsections should be typed in Roman, preceded by two Arabic numbers separated by a dot.

Example:

I. INTRODUCTION

1. *The Jewish context*

1.1 The Land of Israel

II. In all other issues, articles in English must follow the guidelines of *The SBL Handbook of Style*, Peabody, Hendrickson, 2015.
